

Water Fronts for Aug. 11

Pangea and Velero were class winners Saturday in Anacapa Yacht Club's Wes Golemon Memorial Race.

Pangea, a J-30 skippered by Mike Leary, took the Spinnaker Class in the 32 mile race around Anacapa Island.

Velero, an Islander 29 skippered by Brent Swanson was victorious in the non-spinnaker class.

There was also a two-boat multi-hull class, with Mitch Yount taking first in Itchy.

Winds were light at the start, but picked up quickly as the race proceeded into the afternoon. Most of the non-spinnaker boats were able to finish by 6:30 p.m.

Competition was tight, with Velero winning the Wes Golemon overall trophy by just 28 seconds over Pangea.

Velero's victory increased that boat's lead in the Ventura County High Point Standings and in the Association of Santa Barbara Channel Yacht Clubs High Point Series.

The race was the final event in Anacapa Yacht Club's Anacapa Island Series. Angry Hillbillies, an Olson 30 co-skippered by Paul Moore and Deke Klatt won the spinnaker class in the series, while Gary Goodman's Catalina 35, Alcyone, took top honors in the non-spinnaker class.
