

Water Fronts for July 22

Wind Dancer so thoroughly hammered the fleet on corrected time in last weekend's Milt Ingram Trophy Race, that the crew was able to stop the boat and give aid to a boat in distress - and still win.

Wind Dancer, a Catalina 42, co-skippered by PK Edwards and his son, Vance, of Ventura Yacht Club, was the overall winner in the popular race hosted by Pierpont Bay Yacht Club. The Wind Dancer crew stopped and gave assistance to the crew of Funatic, which was dismasted. Wind Dancer was later credited by the race committee with a 20 minute time allowance for rendering assistance. But Wind Dancer was the overall winner even without the extra time allowance, nipping Dr. Laura Schlessinger's J-100, Perfect, by 13 seconds. With the time allowance, Wind Dancer, was the winner by 20 minutes, 13 seconds. Wind Dancer was the winner in the Spinnaker C class and overall. Perfect was the winner in Class B, just two seconds ahead of Angry Hillbillies, an Olson 30, co-skippered by Paul Moore and Deke Klatt.

- Bluebird, a J-120, skippered by Tom Cullen of Santa Barbara Yacht Club, in Spinnaker A.
- R Escape, a Catalina 320 skippered by Verne Haller of Pierpont Bay Yacht Club in non-spinnaker D.
- Out Patient, a Cal 29 skippered by Randy Alcorn of Anacapa Yacht Club in non-spinnaker E.
- Honukai, an F-28 skippered by Lee Edwards of Ventura Sailing Club, the Multi-hull class.
- Gonzo, a Formula 18 skippered by Alexander Van Brunt in the beach catamaran class.

The 42-mile race, second in PBYC's Island Series, attracted 40 boats. The final race in the series will be the Tri Point Race on Aug. 21.
